Application Checklist



Eligibility

- Applicant must be a citizen or lawful permanent resident of the US.
- Applicant must be able to pass background clearance requirements for federal employees
- Applicant must have no record of academic misconduct
- Applicant must be a fulltime student during the scholarship period

Application Package

- Signed application form.
- Up-to-date resume. The following information must be included: education history; employment history; list of scholarships, awards, honors; extracurricular activities, clubs, athletics; veteran or military status.
- A personal statement. Please describe in detail your motivation for applying to SFS, interests in cybersecurity as a profession, and readiness to work for the government.
- Two letters of recommendation. For applicants who have taken courses at KU EECS, we strongly recommend at least one letter from EECS faculty. Please arrange the letters to be sent directly from the recommenders to sfs@ku.edu. We do not require any specific format.

Application Deadlines

- For scholarships starting in fall: April 30, 2021
- For scholarships starting in spring: November 1, 2021
